WHAT IS CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT?

Neglect is a failure to meet the child's basic needs.

Physical abuse refers to the injury of a child on purpose.

Sexual abuse is the use, persuasion or forcing of a child to engage in sexual acts or imitation of such acts.

DO YOU KNOW WHAT GROOMING IS?

Grooming is when someone tries to build trusting relationships with children or families with the aim of child sexual abuse. Grooming can happen face to face or online.
